**Topic: The Great Financial Derivative Crash of 2007**

The speaker, Michael Aguirre, is the former City Attorney for San Diego and is now conducting private practice in San Diego with the legal firm Aguirre, Morris, & Severson.



Mr. Aguirre will discuss the worldwide reform of the banking system and financial securities, and the reform necessary to prevent another derivative market crash.

He will explain how the prevention of a future derivative crash will positively influence job growth, full employment, investment liquidity, state and local revenue, infrastructure improvements, environmental and sustainable enhancements, and the provision of adequate social services, including healthcare and Medicare.

Mr. Aguirre will outline the issues and offer solutions for dealing with Wall Street's misbehavior and the devastating resultant impact on Main Street and Our Street.

This is a complicated but critical issue that will affect all of us and one which Michael Aguirre will help us to understand.
